PORTFOLIO CHECKLIST

- The official application form, including answers to the following questions on a separate piece of paper.
 - Has any of your work been used by the professional media? If yes, please explain.
 - What aspect of journalism and mass communication is your career goal?
 - Do you plan to enroll this year in a university journalism degree program?
 - List the colleges which you are considering attending in order of preference. If you have definitely decided which school you will attend, list only that college.

- Self-analytical evaluation of your "journalistic life."
- Official transcript.
- Action photo of you doing something journalistic.
- Three or four letters of recommendation.
- Samples of your work.
- A self-addressed, padded, stamped envelope large enough to hold your portfolio, if you want it returned.
- Verify your adviser is a current national JEA member. You will be disqualified at the national level if your adviser is not a member.
- Entire portfolio should be no more than 46 one-sided or 23 two-sided pages. Broadcast tape, limited to 15 minutes, should be cued to the student's best work.
