SERVICE TO SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY AWARD

Deadline for entries: **Postmarked by March 2, 2010**

This honor is given to a high school publication staff that has clearly demonstrated service to its school and community. The award singles out a staff for distinction if it has reached “beyond the schoolyard gate” to explore the important relationships and interactions between a community and its school.

To enter, an adviser should submit this entry blank and a summary of how the publication serves its students’ interests, school development and community relations in an outstanding way.

Along with this summary, the adviser might wish to supply supporting information, such as news stories, photos, editorials and letters received from school/community officials. Yearbook entries might want to include layout copies of a detailed explanation of layout being planned for the new yearbook.

Newspaper and yearbook staffs may combine efforts to demonstrate joint responsibility in supplying outstanding efforts. All materials must be the work of a NIPA-member staff or staffs, and all ideas must be original.
